"Don't Forget About Us" current single makes digital download debut on December

13th, with 5 different remixes for 5 separate online retailers: iTunes, MSN Music,

Napster, Real/Rhapsody, and Yahoo! Music Engine

(**Dec. 8, 2005 – New York, NY**) Performer and songwriter **Mariah Carey** made a personal appearance at Gotham Hall in Manhattan this morning, where she joined fellow artists to announce nominees for the upcoming 48th annual Grammy Awards – and then went on to collect 8 nominations herself (tied for the highest number of nominations this year), it was announced by Antonio "L.A." Reid, Chairman, Island Def Jam Music Group. Mariah's Grammy Awards nominations include:

Album of the Year - The Emancipation of Mimi
Song of the Year - "We Belong Together"
Record of the Year - "We Belong Together"
Best Female Pop Vocal Performance - "It's Like That"
Best Female R&B Vocal Performance - "We Belong Together"
Best Traditional R&B Vocal Performance - "Mine Again"
Best R&B Song - "We Belong Together"
Best Contemporary R&B Album

Mariah's 5x-platinum Island Records album, *The Emancipation Of Mimi*, which has sold more than 7 million copies worldwide, generated Grammy Award nominations across the board in several areas, including the General Field (Record Of the Year and Song of the Year for "We Belong Together," and Album Of the Year), and the Pop Field (Best Female Pop Vocal Performance for "It's Like That"). In the R&B Field, "We Belong Together" was nominated for Best Female R&B Vocal Performance and Best R&B Song, "Mine Again" was nominated for Best Female R&B Vocal Performance, and *Mimi* was nominated for Best Contemporary R&B Album. Grammy winners will be announced on Wednesday, February 8, 2006, at Staples Center in Los Angeles, broadcast on the CBS television network (and around the world), 8:00-11:30 p.m. (EST/PST).

Mariah's Grammy Awards nominations follow her recent string of wins at the *VIBE* Awards, the American Music Awards – and earlier this week at the 2005 <u>Billboard</u> Music Awards, where she was named Top R&B Singles Artist - Female, Top R&B/Hip-Hop Artist - Female, Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums Artist - Female, and Top Overall Albums Artist - Female, with "**We Belong Together**" named the #1 Hot 100 Single Of the Year.

Sights are now set on the historic December 13th Internet retail roll-out of the current #2 Hot 100 Airplay smash, "Don't Forget About Us." Written by Mariah Carey and produced by Jermaine Dupri and Mariah Carey, and mixed by Phil Tan and Jermaine Dupri, "Don't Forget About Us" is currently available only as a physical single or one of the four new tracks on *THE EMANCIPATION OF MIMI: ULTRA PLATINUM* EDITION. In an unprecedented release, "Don't Forget About Us" will now be available as a digital download in five different remixes, each one exclusive to a separate digital retailer:

- Real/Rhapsody: "Don't Forget About Us (Ralphi Rosario and Craig Martini Vocal)" (7:41), remix produced, programmed & engineered by Ralphi Rosario & Craig J. Snider;
- Yahoo! Music Engine: "Don't Forget About Us (Quentin Shelter Anthem Mix)" (12:29), a Quentin Harris re-production.

The first-time digital roll-out of "Don't Forget About Us" expands Mariah's sales presence on the Internet, where cumulative ring-tone downloads of <u>MIMI</u>'s three singles – "We Belong Together," "Shake It Off," and "Don't Forget About Us" – have surpassed the 2 million mark.

Mariah's sweep of the 2005 <u>Billboard</u> Music Awards follows her recent wins at last month's 33rd annual American Music Awards (where was voted Favorite Soul/Rhythm & Blues Female Artist by the 20,000 record-buyers whose votes determine the winners); and 3rd annual *VIBE* Awards, where Mariah won for Artist Of The Year, Album Of The Year, R&B Voice Of The Year, and Best R&B Song for "We Belong Together," the most awards won by any individual artist this year.

<u>ULTRA PLATINUM EDITION</u> (which arrived in stores November 15th), the expanded new configuration of her 5x-platinum Island Records album, stays inside the top 10 on the pop and R&B charts in its 34th week out. <u>ULTRA PLATINUM EDITION</u> recaps all 14 tracks on <u>THE EMANCIPATION OF MIMI</u> and adds four new tracks: "Don't Forget About Us," #1 most-added at Pop, Rhythm and Urban radio formats as it moves to the top of the charts; "So Lonely (One and Only Part 2)," Mariah's collaboration with Twista (with a new extra verse written by Mariah); the remix of "We Belong Together" featuring Jadakiss and Styles P. (previously only available digitally online); and "Making It Last All Night (What It Do)," featuring Jermaine Dupri. <u>MIMI</u> is currently tied as 2005's highest certified record to date, according to the RIAA

<u>ULTRA PLATINUM EDITION</u> is also available as a special deluxe limited edition two-disc (CD + DVD) package. The exclusive DVD contains full-length video clips for "It's Like That," "We Belong Together," "Shake It Off," and "Get Your Number" (featuring Jermaine Dupri, making its U.S. debut here); a never-before-seen interview – "Mariah: In Her Own Words," plus a link to access the brand new video for "Don't Forget About Us."

In early September, Mariah became the first female lead artist in the 47 years of the <u>Billboard</u> Hot 100 <u>ever</u> to occupy the #1 and #2 spots in the same week, with "We **Belong Together**" (her 16th #1 career single) and "Shake It Off," respectively. The biggest single in the history of both Mariah and the Island Def Jam Music Group, "We **Belong Together**" hit an astonishing 14 weeks at #1. This positions Mariah as the only active artist with the potential to match or surpass the Beatles (with 20 #1's) and Elvis Presley (18 #1's) in the modern era.
